The Southern New Jersey Continuum of Care (SNJCoC) is an association of county-wide homelessness Continuums of Care that provides information, services and advocacy for and on behalf of the homeless population in the area of service within the participating Southern NJ Counties (Camden, Cape May, Cumberland and Gloucester). The mission of the Southern New Jersey Continuum of Care is to work to prevent and end homelessness through a public and private collaboration that maximizes efforts and leverages resources.

Applications for renewal projects will be accepted from those organizations interested in applying for renewal of their **HUD funding** to provide housing and supportive services in 2016. A Review Process administered by CPAC: The Community Planning & Advocacy Council will evaluate proposals and make recommendations to the SNJCoC Executive Board on the prioritization of these funds.
