 Access to Reproductive Care & HIV Services
 Nurses in Harm Reduction Programs

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Gloucester County remains dedicated to reducing the spread of HIV/AIDS and other infectious diseases. To achieve this objective ARCH nurses provide prevention services to at-risk individuals in the community. A registered nurse is available to assist anyone who may be at risk of getting or transmitting HIV/AIDS, STDs, Hepatitis or other infections and for women who may be pregnant and at risk for these diseases.

You are at risk if you:

- ◆ Currently use or have used injection drugs, especially if you have shared needles/syringes, cottons, cookers, or water
- ◆ Have shared vaginal, anal or oral sex with someone who uses injection drugs without using a condom or other barrier
- ◆ Have shared vaginal, anal or oral sex with more than one partner without using a condom or other barrier
- ◆ Have shared vaginal, anal or oral sex with multiple partners without using a condom or other barrier
- ◆ Have an open wound or abscess resulting from injection drug use or an untreated STI



ARCH Nurse Services Include:

- ◆ Sexual and Reproductive health counseling
- ◆ Nutrition counseling
- ◆ Rapid HIV testing
- ◆ PrEP counseling & referral
- ◆ Rapid Hepatitis C testing
- ◆ STD testing and treatment
- ◆ Pregnancy testing
- ◆ Adult vaccinations
- ◆ Wound Assessment and care
- ◆ Referrals for HIV, Hepatitis, & Pregnancy care and treatment
- ◆ IV drug use risk reduction counseling
- ◆ Overdose prevention counseling (naloxone use)
- ◆ Drug treatment assessment and referral for drug treatment
