### ***Did you know your children's toys may contain lead?***

- Lead has been found in items which you and your children use on a regular basis.
- As more toys and other household items are imported, lead exposure has increased.
- Consumer products such as spices, cosmetics, candy, toys and housewares may contain lead too. The Gloucester County Health Department has the equipment to test these products.
- Residents can call our office to schedule a drop off of the item(s) they would like tested for lead. We will contact the resident within five business days with the result of the lead testing and schedule the return of the items.
