

PUBLIC QUESTION TO BE VOTED UPON

BOND PROPOSAL QUESTION

The Board of Education of the City of Woodbury in the County of Gloucester, New Jersey is authorized (a) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations, and upgrades to Woodbury Junior/Senior High School, consisting of renovations to the Cap Paine Gym, including renovations to locker rooms, offices fitness and weight room, restroom facilities, classrooms and other improvements to athletic spaces, and the creation of a career and technical education space, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment and any site work; (b) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations and upgrades to the all-purpose room and the construction of an addition at West End Memorial Elementary School, consisting of a gym and pre-school classrooms, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment and any site work; and (c) to appropriate \$22,702,000, and to issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$22,702,000.

The final eligible costs for the projects approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education that are eligible for state aid, are \$12,410,953 (consisting of \$10,052,000 for Woodbury Junior/Senior High School and \$2,358,953 for West End Memorial Elementary School). The project includes \$1,027,741 (consisting of \$0 for Woodbury Junior/Senior High School and \$1,027,741 for West End Memorial Elementary School) for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 68.2918% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this election.
